### I. Topics

#### a. CPR

- Week of August 24, 2015
- Every Coach needs to take if they haven't done so already.
- Club will cover cost of \$45/coach.
- Discuss Defibrillator on Ralph Ave location and ensure we have, or are handing out keys to the First Aid box to all coaches.
- 50 keys for First Aid Box

#### b. Risk Management

- It is mandatory as per ENYYSA and LIJSL that all volunteers in YOUTH Soccer, especially coaches, to take the online Risk Management.
- Link can be found on the Babylon Soccer Website under RISK MANAGEMENT.
- Coach will pay for Risk Management - \$10/coach
- Travel coaches have already taken it.
- Concussion Training is included in Risk Management
  - There is another free concussion course on line. Link can be found on the Babylon Soccer Website under Coach's Corner/ Safety.

#### c. Coach Training

- All U7, U8, U9 and U10 coaches will need to get either the USSF "F" License
- Anyone that holds a pass that allows them to be on the sidelines at a game involving U7, U8, U9 and U10 groups need to get either the USSF "F" License
- The USSF "F" License on line module (2 hours) is \$25 (each coach will pay on their own). The Field Module (90 minutes) for the USSF "F" License is free until August 31, 2016.
- To move up from U10 to U11, you will need to get the USSF F license by 2016.

#### d. Game Day

- U5 to U8 season will begin September 20, 2015; week after Country Fair.
- Intramural U7/U8 will have schedule setup by Intramural Coordinator and VP of Coaching.
- Will have separate meeting to discuss teams and schedules - Mid August
- VP of Coaching will email U7/U8 parents for additional volunteers

- 6 teams for boys - 39 boys (need 3 head coaches and 4 assistants)
  - 4 teams for girls - 23 girls (need 1 head coach and 1 assistant)
